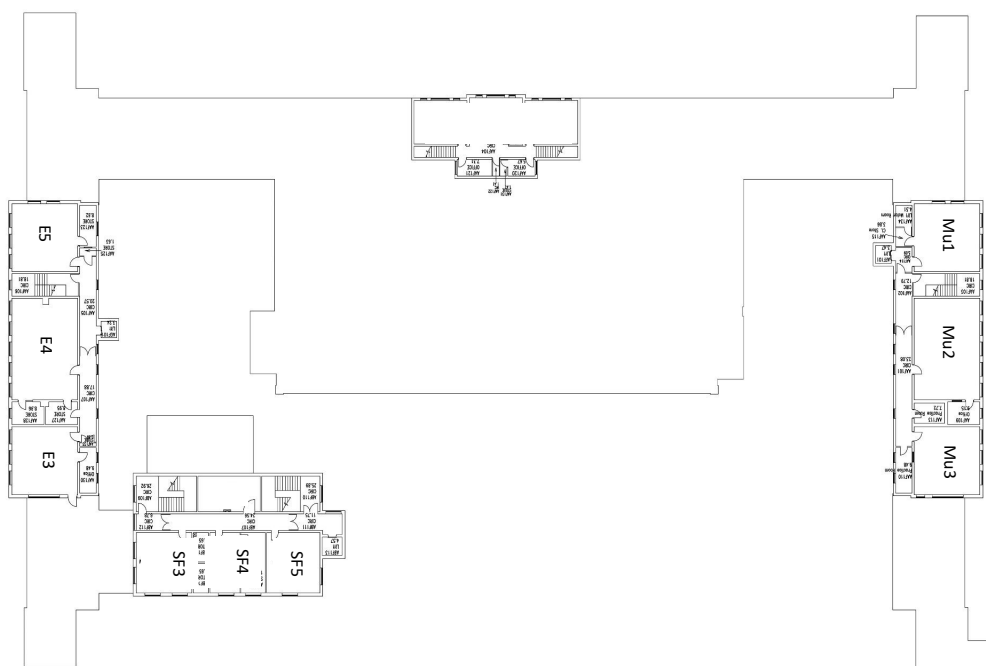
## Dixons Broadgreen Academy fire and emergency evacuation plans

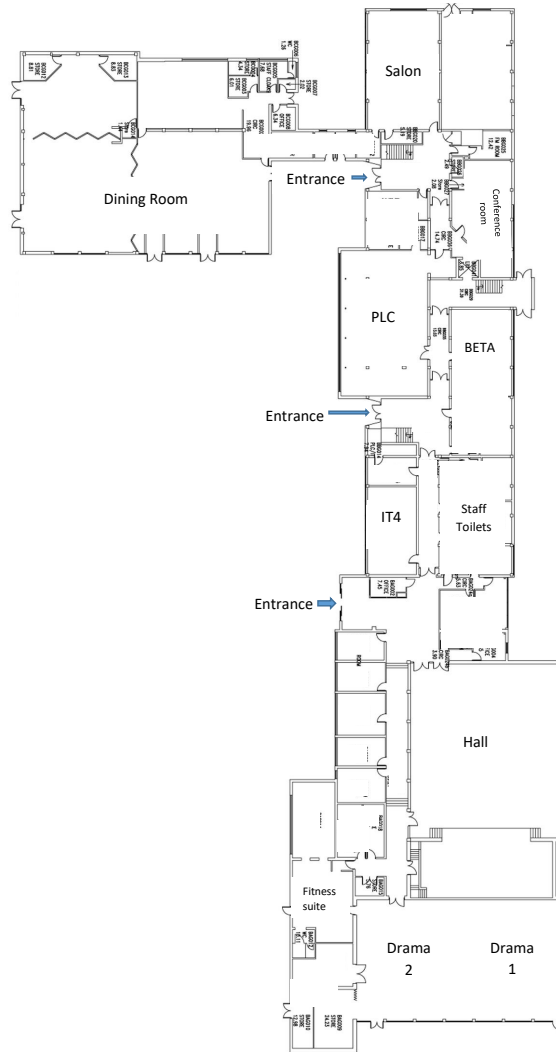
### Ground floor, technology and sixth form



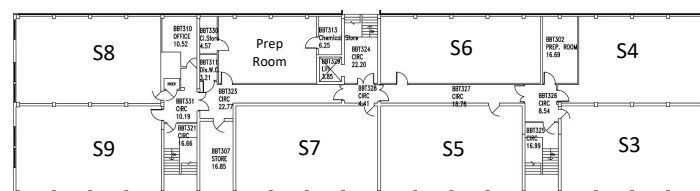
### First floor



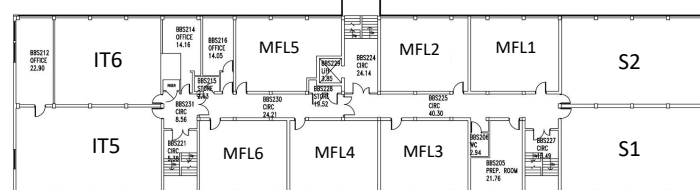
## Stephenson - ground floor



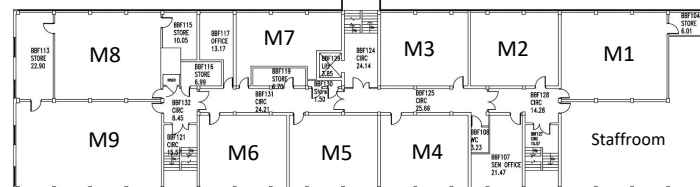
## Stephenson - first floor
