### By tram


The academy is opposite the Moor Road tram stop

Parking onsite will be restricted due to the volume of people. We urge you to car share to get to our academy.







### Dixons Brooklands Academy fire and emergency evacuation plans

Please see below the floor plans and all fire and emergency evacuation routes and assembly points. Staff will guide you to the nearest exit in an emergency but please ensure that you are familiar with the routes from the area which you will be in on the day, there is an escape plan in each room. Once evacuated, the assembly point for all guests will be the G3 pitch at the back of the academy. All guests must remain here until all attendants are accounted for and the site team have confirmed that it is safe to re-enter the building.
